Stantonbury Campus Leisure Centre working with Acorn Child Care - 5-13 year olds

Acorn are in charge of the 5-8 year olds, as this age group has to be Ofsted registered
8 to 13 years is run by the Leisure Centre

Both are run at the Leisure Centre and enrolment takes place at the Leisure Centre

The staff are qualified and/or experienced in working with children. All staff recruited are professionally interviewed, referenced and background checked, processed through the Criminal Records Bureau (CRB) and are then trained prior to the start of their employment



What's on Offer

- **Sports coaching activities;** this could be
 - **Trampolining**
 - **Football**
 - **Athletics**
 - **Table Tennis**
 - **Dance**
- **Use of the SHOKK youth gym** - full induction carried out plus a programme written just for you
- **Team Games** - this can be anything from a quiz to a treasure hunt or making models
- **Arts & crafts** are available through out the day which also includes the chance to play board games.

Swimming
